

CIBOR receives \$1.5 million from Kansas Bioscience Authority

The **Kansas Bioscience Authority** has awarded the Center of Innovation for Biomaterials in Orthopaedic Research \$1.5 million to help fund its work with medical composites.

The Wichita-based center is focused on using research from aviation composites — blending metals into a stronger, lighter part — to help develop a similar industry for medical devices and uses, such as joint replacements.

CIBOR's funding is part of \$4.4 million the KBA awarded. The grants were announced Tuesday.
